- The Tornado threat for South Carolina is now minimal












Hazards Map




Multiple areas in South **Carolina and Georgia** still under a **Flood** Watch (dark green) and a **Flood Warning** (light green)








Expected Storm Total Rainfall and Chance of Rainfall Flooding


