







#### 0-3 Day Most Likely Arrival Time of Tropical-Storm-Force Winds















#### Key Messages for Tropical Storm Ernesto Advisory 7: 5:00 AM AST Tue Aug 13, 2024



- Ernesto is expected to bring tropical storm conditions to portions of the Leeward Islands today and to the Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico by late today or tonight. Tropical Storm Warnings are in effect for this entire area.
- 2. Heavy rainfall may result in locally considerable flash flooding and mudslides in areas of the Leeward Islands through today, and over the Virgin Islands into Puerto Rico by later today through Wednesday.
- 3. It is too soon to know what impacts Ernesto could bring to Bermuda late this week, and interests there should monitor the progress of this system.

- Seas will begin to increase across the USVI and PR today, peaking to around 20 ft tonight into Wednesday morning
- Conditions will begin to improve Thursday morning, with seas dropping below 8 ft by Thursday afternoon
