










## Forecast Information

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
- Ernesto is now making a NW turn and should pass over the Virgin Islands later this evening (Tue)
- Ernesto is expected to pass northeast and north over Puerto Rico tonight (Tue) into Wednesday
- Ernesto has the chance to strengthen into a hurricane tonight – and hurricane hunters will be investigating the storm this evening to investigate further
- Current center forecast positions through the next 5 days (if applicable) illustrated by dots
- through day 3
- White swath of potential track error added to each side of the forecast track
- Hatched swatch of potential track error added to each side of the forecast track days 4-5

\*\* Swaths are calculated using average track errors and actual track may be well inside, or possibly outside the potential track areas indicated.

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

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










### Expected Storm Total Rainfall and Chance of Rainfall Flooding


#### Key Messages for Tropical Storm Ernesto Advisory 9: 5:00 PM AST Tue Aug 13, 2024

1. Tropical storm conditions are expected to continue over portions of the northern Leeward Islands this evening and spread westward to the Virgin Islands and Puerto Rico this evening and tonight. Hurricane conditions are also possible on the Virgin Islands, Culebra, and Vieques this evening and tonight.

2. Heavy rainfall may result in locally considerable flash flooding and mudslides in areas of the Leeward Islands through this evening, and over the Virgin Islands into Puerto Rico by this evening through Wednesday.

3. Ernesto is likely to bring impacts to Bermuda late this week, and interests there should monitor the progress of this system.

4. Swells generated by Ernesto are expected to affect portions of the Virgin Islands, Puerto Rico, the Dominican Republic, the Turks and Caicos, and the Bahamas during the next few days and then reach the east coast of the United States and Bermuda late this week and into the weekend. These swells are likely to cause life-threatening surf and rip current conditions.

### Marine Key Messages:

- Seas are expected to continue building across the USVI/PR, peaking around 20-25 ft tonight through Wednesday morning
- By Wednesday afternoon, seas will slowly subside and drop below 8 ft by Thursday morning
