

Surface Wind Field of Hurricane Lisa Sustained Winds as of 500 AM AST Mon Jul 17 2023 Advisory Number 19





- Lisa will move over the Old Bahama Channel tonight, and approach the Florida Keys and South Florida Tuesday night
- Hurricane Warnings and Storm Surge Warnings have been issued for the Florida Keys and portions of South Florida.
- Lisa is forecast to remain a hurricane through Wednesday night.
- Current center forecast positions through the next 5 days illustrated by dots
- White swath is potential track error through day 3
- Hatched swatch is potential track error on days 4-5

** Swaths are designed so the actual track will occur inside the cone two-thirds of the time. One-third of the time, the center will track outside the cone.


NOTE: Do not focus on the exact track. Impacts can occur well outside the area enclosed by the cone.




Tropical-Storm-Force Wind Speed Probabilities


 Probabilities of sustained tropical storm force winds (34 kt to 63 kt) over the next 5 days, based off this cyclone's wind radii and track.




Hurricane-Force Wind Speed Probabilities

For the 96 hours (4.00 days) from 2 AM ASTMON JUL 17 to 2 AM AST FRI JUL 21







Most Likely Arrival Time of Tropical-Storm-Force Winds





- The most likely time of arrival of Tropical Storm Force Winds (34kt to 63 kt) for this cyclone based off the current track and wind radii.



 A storm surge of 3-5 ft above ground level is forecast along coastal areas of South Florida, with 2-4 ft for portions of the Florida Keys




- Total rainfall in inches over the next 3 days
