- Lisa will move over the Old Bahama Channel tonight, and approach the Florida Keys and South Florida Tuesday night
- Hurricane Warnings and Storm Surge Warnings for the Florida Keys and South Florida.
- Hurricane Watch and Storm Surge Watch for Tampa Bay
- Lisa is forecast to remain a hurricane through Wednesday night.
- Current center forecast positions through the next 5 days illustrated by dots
- White swath is potential track error through day 3
- Hatched swatch is potential track error on days 4-5

** Swaths are designed so the actual track will occur inside the cone two-thirds of the time. One-third of the time, the center will track outside the cone.

NOTE: Do not focus on the exact track. Impacts can occur well outside the area enclosed by the cone.




Tropical-Storm-Force Wind Speed Probabilities






Hurricane-Force Wind Speed Probabilities



 Probabilities of sustained hurricane force winds (64 kt +) over the next 5 days, based off this cyclone's wind radii and track.




Most Likely Arrival Time of Tropical-Storm-Force Winds






- South FL and the FL Keys: Tuesday afternoon
- Tampa Bay area: Early Wed
- The most likely time of arrival of Tropical Storm Force Winds (34kt to 63 kt) for this cyclone based off the current track and wind radii.



- A storm surge of 4-7 ft above ground level is expected along the SW coast of Florida.
- A storm surge of 3-5 ft above ground level is forecast to occur somewhere along the coast near Biscayne Bay.
- A storm surge of 2-4 ft is forecast for portions of the Florida Keys.




- Total rainfall in inches over the next 3 days
- Rainfall amounts 6-12" with localized amounts of 20" possible
