



### Forecast Information

#### Hurricane Milton



**NOTE:** Do not focus on the exact track. Impacts can occur well outside the area enclosed by the cone.

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- Milton will move toward the northeast at about the same speed through Thursday
- The major hurricane will make landfall somewhere between Port Charlotte and Cedar Key Wednesday night as a large Category 3 or 4 hurricane
- After passing over Florida, Milton will accelerate over the Atlantic while weakening and transitioning into an extratropical cyclone
- Current center forecast positions through the next 5 days (if applicable) illustrated by dots
- White swath of potential track error added to each side of the forecast track through day 3
- Hatched swatch of potential track error added to each side of the forecast track days 4-5

\*\* Swaths are calculated using average track errors and actual track may be well inside, or possibly outside the potential track areas indicated.










#### Most Likely Time of Arrival and Tropical Storm Windspeed Probabilities





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


**Possible river flooding** for west-central and northeast Florida after Milton passes through


#### Key Messages for Hurricane Milton Advisory 13: 4:00 AM CDT Tue Oct 08, 2024

 Damaging hurricane-force winds and a life-threatening storm surge with destructive waves are expected across portions of the northern coast of the Yucatan Peninsula today.

2. Milton is expected to grow in size and remain an extremely dangerous hurricane when it approaches the west coast of Florida on Wednesday. A large area of destructive storm surge will occur along parts of the west coast of Florida. This is an extremely life-threatening situation and residents in those areas should follow advice given by local officials and evacuate immediately if told to do so.

3. Devastating hurricane-force winds are expected along portions of the west coast of Florida, where a Hurricane Warning is in effect. Milton is forecast to remain a hurricane as it crosses the Florida Peninsula and lifethreatening hurricane-force winds, especially in gusts, are expected to spread inland across the peninsula. Preparations to protect life and property in the warning areas should be complete by tonight.

4. Areas of heavy rainfall will continue to impact portions of Florida well ahead of Milton through early Thursday. This rainfall brings the risk of life-threatening flash, urban and aerial flooding along with moderate to major river flooding. Flooding will be exacerbated in areas where coastal and inland flooding combine to increase the overall threat.

#### Marine Key Messages:

- Dangerous seas are expanding across the central and eastern Gulf of Mexico by late today
- Peak seas will recede by Thursday night over the Gulf
- Seas over the Atlantic will rapidly build on Wednesday and continue through Saturday
