
## Changes since the last briefing Hurricane Oscar

- Hurricane and Tropical Storm Warnings have been discontinued for the Turks and Caicos









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Oscar remains a small category I hurricane on a WSW track toward eastern Cuba

- Oscar is expected to weaken over eastern Cuba but could still be a tropical storm as it leaves Cuba on Monday and moves across the central Bahamas afterwards
- Oscar is forecast to turn north and northeast early next week, keeping the system away from Florida

\*\* Swaths are calculated using average track errors and actual track may be well inside, or possibly outside the potential track areas indicated.















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






#### Key Messages for Hurricane Oscar Advisory 5: 5:00 AM EDT Sun Oct 20, 2024

1. A Hurricane Warning remains in effect for the southeastern Bahamas and for a portion of the northeastern coast of Cuba.

2. Oscar is expected to produce a dangerous storm surge on portions of the southeastern Bahamas this morning, especially Great Inagua Island, and along the north shore of Cuba later this afternoon and evening.

3. Heavy rainfall from Oscar will lead to areas of flash flooding along with possible mudslides across portions of eastern Cuba, especially within the Sierra Maestra, through Tuesday.




