


- Oscar rapidly developed east of the Turks and Caicos








- No wind probabilities for the ports in southern Florida.



Key Messages for Hurricane Oscar Special Advisory 2: 2:00 PM EDT Sat Oct 19, 2024


- 1. Oscar is now expected to bring hurricane conditions to portions of the southeastern Bahamas, Turks and Caicos Islands, and eastern Cuba during the next day or so. A Hurricane Warning has now been issued for those locations.
- Oscar is expected to produce a dangerous storm surge on the Turks and Caicos Islands beginning this evening.
- 3. Locally heavy rainfall is possible across the Turks and Caicos Islands and the southeastern Bahamas later today and tonight. These rains are expected to spread to eastern Cuba on Sunday.
