





** Swaths are calculated using average track errors and actual track may be well inside, or possibly outside the potential track areas indicated.




T.S. Wind Speed Probabilities


- 5-10% over portions of Puerto Rico.










Key Messages for Tropical Storm Earl

Advisory 2: 5:00 AM AST Sat Sep 03, 2022

- 1. Tropical Storm Earl is forecast to pass near or just to the north of the northern Leeward Islands, the Virgin Islands, and Puerto Rico over the weekend. Gusty winds, especially in squalls, area possible on those islands over the next day or two.
- 2. Heavy rainfall from Earl is expected to lead to limited flash, urban, and small stream flooding impacts over the Leeward Islands, U.S. and British Virgin Islands, and Puerto Rico this weekend. Rapid rises on rivers are possible in Puerto Rico.

Marine Key Messages:

- With the passage of Earl to the NE and N of Puerto Rico, winds will shift more north on Sunday, and then southerly by Sunday night.
- Seas will also increase in the Atlantic waters during the weekend due to the passage of Earl, with conditions in the northern outer waters becoming hazardous.
- Thunderstorms are expected over the local waters through the weekend.
