Rafael has made landfall in the Cuban province of Artemisa just east of Playa Majana.





- High uncertainty in both track and intensity remains beyond Fri night




Key West 10%

Hurricane Wind Speed Probabilities
















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Expected Storm Total Rainfall and Chance of Rainfall Flooding



Slight risk of tornadoes in the Florida Keys and extreme SW Florida through Thursday morning



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


Key Messages for Hurricane Rafael Advisory 13: 4:00 PM EST Wed Nov 06, 2024



- 1. Rafael is forecast to cross western Cuba as a major hurricane this afternoon and evening. A hurricane warning is in effect for this region, where a life-threatening storm surge, damaging hurricane-force winds, and destructive waves are expected.
- 2. Tropical-storm-force winds, especially in gusts, are expected in the Lower and Middle Florida Keys beginning later today and tonight.
- 3. Rafael will bring areas of heavy rain to the Cayman Islands and western Cuba through Thursday. Flash flooding and mudslides are expected in areas of higher terrain in western Cuba.
- 4. Rafael is forecast to meander over the south-central Gulf of Mexico this weekend and early next week. Interests in the southern and southwestern Gulf of Mexico should monitor the progress of this system.
