




Hazards Map

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




Tropical Weather Outlook




- We continue to monitor a trough of low pressure (yellow area) for potential tropical cyclone formation in the next 48 hours.




















Key Messages for Hurricane Rafael



- 1. Swells generated by Rafael are likely to cause life-threatening surf and rip current conditions along the Gulf Coast for the next few days.
- 2. Rafael is forecast to move slowly over the south-central Gulf of Mexico this weekend and early next week. Interests in the southern and southwestern Gulf of Mexico should monitor the progress of this system.
