



 One or more bands or squall lines of severe thunderstorms with very strong winds possible tonight and Tue, all Gulf and Atlantic waters.
















#### STORM TOTAL RAINFALL

Risk of rainfall exceeding flash flood guidance within 25 miles of a point



 Southerly gales of 30 to 40 kt offshore Florida's Atlantic coast, N of West Palm Beach, late tonight through Tue night

 Severe thunderstorms along and ahead of a cold front tonight through Tue, wind and tornado threat increases farther N.
