





- Eleven will continue towards the westnorthwest for three or four days, then turn towards the northwest
- System expected to become Tropical Storm Josephine today or tonight
- However, it is not anticipated to become a hurricane and is forecast to weaken to a depression by day 5
- Current center forecast positions through the next 5 days illustrated by dots
- White swath of potential track is average track error added to each side of the forecast track through day 3
- Hatched swatch of potential track is average track error added to each side of the forecast track days 4-5

** Swaths are calculated using average track errors and actual track may be well inside, or possibly outside the potential track areas indicated.



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















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



- Total rainfall in inches through Monday morning.
- Current expectation for Puerto Rico and U.S. Virgin Islands is 2-3"

Tropical Depression Eleven





- Low impact expected for Winds and Rainfall
- Eleven will continue towards the westnorthwest for three or four days, then turn towards the northwest
- System expected to become Tropical
 Storm Josephine today or tonight
- However, it is not anticipated to become a hurricane and is forecast to weaken to a depression by day 5
- Marine Key Messages:
- Current peak seas 12 ft well east of the Caribbean
- Seas only slightly larger from Friday through Monday, well north of Puerto Rico and U.S. Virgin Islands
