



- Idalia just made landfall as a 125-mph Category 3
 Hurricane at 7:45 am near Keaton Beach, FL
- Idalia will turn gradually toward the E during the next two days at about the same forward speed
- After landfall, Idalia will weaken while it tracks along the coast of Georgia and the Carolinas
- Idalia is anticipated to produce hurricane conditions along the Georgia and South Carolina coastline
- Current center forecast positions through the next 5 days (if applicable) illustrated by dots
- White swath of potential track error added to each side of the forecast track through day 3
- Hatched swatch of potential track error added to each side of the forecast track days 4-5
























Expected Storm Total Rainfall and Chance of Rainfall Flooding






Tornado Outlook – Day I






Key Messages for Hurricane IdaliaAdvisory 15: 5:00 AM EDT Wed Aug 30, 2023

- 1. Catastrophic impacts from storm surge inundation of 12 to 16 feet above ground level and destructive waves are expected somewhere between the Wakulla/Jefferson County line and Yankeetown, Florida. Life-threatening storm surge inundation is likely elsewhere along portions of the Florida Gulf Coast where a Storm Surge Warning is in effect. Residents in these areas should follow any advice given by local officials.
- 2. Destructive life-threatening winds will occur where the core of Idalia moves onshore in the Big Bend region of Florida, with hurricane conditions expected elsewhere in portions of the Hurricane Warning area along the Florida Gulf Coast. Strong winds will also spread inland across portions of northern Florida and southern Georgia near the track of the center of Idalia where Hurricane Warnings are in effect. Residents in these areas should be prepared for long-duration power outages. Damaging hurricane-force winds are likely in portions of eastern Georgia and southeastern South Carolina where Hurricane Warnings are now in effect.
- 3. Areas of flash, urban, and moderate river flooding, with considerable impacts, are expected from the Florida Big Ben through, central Georgia and South Carolina, through eastern North Carolina into Thursday.

Gulf:

- Seas are currently 25 ft
- Conditions will improve over the eastern Gulf by tonight

Atlantic:

- Conditions will improve off the SE US coast by Thu night
