



- ** Swaths are calculated using average track errors and actual track may be well inside, or possibly outside the potential track areas indicated.






- Probabilities of sustained tropical storm force winds (34 kt to 63 kt) over the next 5 days, based off this cyclone's wind radii and track.





- 1. Areas of flash, urban, and moderate river flooding, with considerable impacts, will continue across coastal North Carolina through today.
