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



- White swath of potential track is average track error added to each side of the forecast track through day 3
- Hatched swatch of potential track is average track error added to each side of the forecast track days 4-5

** Swaths are calculated using average track errors and actual track may be well inside, or possibly outside the potential track areas indicated.









Marine Key Messages:

- Current peak seas 15 ft well east of the Leeward Islands
- Seas only slightly larger on Saturday then decreasing through Tuesday, well north of Puerto Rico and U.S.Virgin Islands
