



- •Rare event:
  - Sep 2002
  - Jun 1959
  - Sep 1933

#### **Tropical Storm Marco**



- Marco is forecast to strengthen thru early Mon
- •Weakening is forecast as the system approaches the northwestern Gulf coast thru Tuesday.
- •It is still too soon to know exactly the location and magnitude of impacts the system will produce along the central or northwestern Gulf Coast


- Gradual strengthening is expected





- Clear or dark green are the lowest chances of 0-30%.
- Yellow to orange is 31-70%
- Red through purple are the highest probabilities of 71%-100%



- Likely near Louisiana by Tue a day after Marco


