




A Tropical Storm Warning is in effect for Intracoastal City Louisiana to the Okaloosa/Walton County Florida line, including Lake Pontchartrain and Lake Maurepas

**NOTE:** Do not focus on the exact track. Impacts can occur well outside the area enclosed by the cone.








#### 0-3 Day Earliest Reasonable Arrival Time of Tropical-Storm-Force Winds






- Tropical-storm-force winds could arrive onshore by early evening
- The earliest reasonable time of arrival of Tropical Storm Force Winds (34kt to 63 kt) for this cyclone based off the current track and wind radii.
- Clear or dark green are the lowest chances of 0-30%.
- Yellow to orange is 31-70%
- Red through purple are the highest probabilities of 71%-100%









Tropical Storm Cristobal








 Total rainfall in inches during the time span stated on the map. Risk of rainfall exceeding flash flood guidance within 25 miles of a point

HIGH: > 50% SLGT: 10%-20%


MDT: 20%-50% MRGL: 5%-10%

Minor to moderate river flooding is forecast through Jun 19 for some rivers and streams in Louisiana, Mississippi, and Arkansas







## Key Messages for Tropical Storm Cristobal Advisory 20: 10:00 AM CDT Sat Jun 06, 2020



- 1. There is a danger of life-threatening storm surge outside of the Hurricane and Storm Damage Risk Reduction System from the Mouth of the Mississippi River to Ocean Springs, Mississippi, and a Storm Surge Warning is in effect for those areas. Life-threatening storm surge remains possible in other portions of southern and southeastern Louisiana where a Storm Surge Watch is in effect. Residents in these locations should follow advice given by local emergency officials.
- Tropical storm force winds are expected by late tonight along the northern Gulf Coast from central Louisiana to the western Florida Panhandle, including metropolitan New Orleans, and a Tropical Storm Warning is in effect for this area. These winds will arrive well in advance of and extend well east of Cristobal's center.
- 3. Heavy rainfall will continue across west and north Florida today, spreading from east to west across the eastern and central Gulf Coast from the Florida Panhandle into Louisiana today into Sunday. This heavy rain will move into the Lower Mississippi Valley on Monday. Significant flooding will be possible on smaller streams, especially where heavier rainfall occurs over portions of the Gulf Coast and Lower Mississippi Valley.
- 4. Damaging and deadly flooding was already occurring in portions of Mexico and Central America. Additional rainfall from Cristobal will continue to slowly subside, however life-threatening flash floods and mudslides will still be possible through today. - Tropical Storm Warning in effect for central and northern Gulf waters
- Seas will build to near 30 ft over the north central Gulf through Sunday as Cristobal approaches the Gulf Coast
