Hurricane Rafael


- Rafael intensified to a hurricane last night

- High uncertainty in the track forecast remains for the northern Gulf Sunday and Monday
- Current forecast has Rafael in the NW Gulf offshore waters as a Tropical Storm by Monday morning






















Expected Storm Total Rainfall and Chance of Rainfall Flooding





Key Messages for Hurricane Rafael Advisory 12: 10:00 AM EST Wed Nov 06, 2024

- 1. Rafael is forecast to become a major hurricane before it reaches western Cuba and the Isle of Youth. A hurricane warning is in effect for this region, where a life-threatening storm surge, damaging hurricaneforce winds, and destructive waves are expected.
- 2. Tropical-storm-force winds, especially in gusts, are expected in the Lower and Middle Florida Keys beginning later today and tonight.
- 3. Rafael will bring areas of heavy rain to the Cayman Islands and western Cuba through Thursday. Flash flooding and mudslides are expected in areas of higher terrain in western Cuba.
- 4. It is too soon to determine what, if any, impacts Rafael could bring to portions of the western Gulf Coast. Residents in this area should regularly monitor updates to the forecast.
