


- Rafael is a Category Two Hurricane now in the SE Gulf








**NOTE:** Do not focus on the exact track. Impacts can occur well outside the area enclosed by the cone.

- Gradual weakening forecast
- Current forecast has Rafael curving SW starting Sunday, but there is very high uncertainty

- Hurricane Warning






### Hurricane Wind Speed Probabilities


### Rainfall flood potential Saturday/Saturday night






### Key Messages for Hurricane Rafael Advisory 16: 9:00 AM CST Thu Nov 07, 2024



- 1. Hurricane Rafael will continue to bring periods of heavy rain to western Cuba today. Flash flooding and mudslides are possible along the higher terrain.
- 2. Rafael is forecast to move slowly over the south-central Gulf of Mexico this weekend and early next week. Interests in the southern and southwestern Gulf of Mexico should monitor the progress of this system.

### Marine Key Messages:

- Hurricane Force winds and very hazardous seas (30 ft) spreading from SE to Central Gulf of Mexico into the weekend
- Significant uncertainty in forecast track
   late this weekend and beyond
- Current forecast keep most significant impacts away from land
