



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

** Swaths are calculated using average track errors and actual track may be well inside, or possibly outside the potential track areas indicated.





T.S. Wind Speed Probabilities












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









Key Messages for Tropical Storm Zeta Advisory 7: 5:00 AM EDT Mon Oct 26, 2020

- Hurricane conditions and storm surge are expected in portions of the northern Yucatan Peninsula of Mexico tonight and early Tuesday. Tropical storm conditions could occur over extreme western Cuba beginning later today.
- 2. Through Tuesday, heavy rainfall is expected from Zeta across the Yucatan Peninsula of Mexico, the Cayman Islands, and central to western Cuba. This rainfall may lead to flash flooding in urban areas.
- 3. Zeta is forecast to be at or near hurricane strength when it approaches the northern Gulf Coast on Wednesday, and there is an increasing risk of storm surge, rainfall, and wind impacts from Louisiana to the Florida Panhandle. Residents in these areas should monitor the progress of Zeta and updates to the forecast.



- Marine Key Messages:
- Near the northern Gulf coast Wednesday through Wednesday night.
- Near hurricane strength.
